



Other Business:

- Timothy Vaughn resident off of West Road was in to discuss what he need to build a new home – referred him to the Code's Officer. Questioned how to get the old discontinued Bowdoin Road redesignated as a Town maintained road – referred him to the Town Clerk for information on the procedures. Asked about small streams going thru his property – lack of water flow, he was concerned that they might be blocked/dam up – referred him to DEP since the Town has no jurisdiction over matters of such.
- Tom Garrepy – Fire Chief reported that the new fire truck should be ready the middle of December, need to contact bank for financing balance of debt. Have received the hoses for the new truck, will ask that the invoice be split into two invoices instead of one large payment.

New Business:

- Discussed the minutes of the July 26 Planning Board regarding approval of two road designs, the Board not being consistent in their approval process. Not following the Land Use Ordinance nor the E-911 Ordinance in the approval process.
- Talked with Code's Officer concerning frontage for the buildings on 201 for the property at Map 7-26-01 and 7-26-02.
