## BOWDOIN TRANSFER STATION

The Bowdoin transfer station is switching over to Zero-Sort® Recycling. What is Zero-Sort?

Zero-Sort is the single bin recycling service that puts more of your stuff back into the world and less of it into the landfill. No separation or sorting of materials needed – it all goes into the same bin – please make sure your containers are rinsed and free of food waste. Below, please find a list of acceptable items!



### CARDBOARD

Boxboard, corrugated cardboard, product and food packaging boxes such as cereal, pasta, pizza, and tissue, paperboard boxes, beverage holders, paper towel cores, toilet paper cores, and paper bags



### PAPER

Newspaper, junk mail, envelopes, magazines, soft cover books, file folders, any color paper, paper cartons such as milk, egg, and juice boxes



### PLASTIC

Containers, bottles and jugs #1-#7 (# located on the bottom of container) such as empty beverage containers - caps included, beauty and cleaning products, detergents, dairy tubs, plastic take-out containers, rigid plastics such as flower pots, 5 gal. buckets, sleds and kids toy's



### METAL

Aluminum cans, pie plates, trays, foil, tin cans, and small steel containers



### GLASS

Bottles, containers and jars (any color)

**NOT ACCEPTED:** Plastic bags, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, pyrex, ceramics, paper towels, facial tissue, styrofoam, recyclables containing food waste, paints, oils, hazardous material, needles, syringes, VCR tapes, CDs/DVDs, scrap metal, pots and pans
