


**Selectmen's Meeting

- The commitment for 2016 taxes

Audience Participation:

- Tom Garrepy told the selectmen the roof work done on the fire barn was very shoddy. Clyde will call Roger Roy to come back in to see the selectmen.
- Tom said the Bowdoin Fire Auxiliary received a donation of \$50,000.00 from the estate of Mrs. Lancaster.
- Jr. Card asked when the plowing contracts would be going out to bid. Marc said hopefully within the next couple weeks.
- Jr. also said we should be getting a new bid price for salt soon.
- A taxpayer asked what she needs to do to keep her home which is in tax acquired and is now out for bid by the Town. The selectmen told her she needs to submit a bid by 6PM on July 18<sup>th</sup> for enough to cover all unpaid taxes. She was given a bid form.

Other Business:

- Clyde was asked by the Board to put a notice on the website to let people know we are converting to computerized registrations and are in the learning phase which means the lines may be slow moving. Also to remind them that re-registrations may also be done easily on line with Rapid Renewal.
