


**Selectmen's Meeting

Needed is a vacant site of approximately 20,000 net useable square feet. Proposed site size excludes additional area needs for setback, septic, or other special requirements. Property should be properly zoned or capable of being rezoned for use as a postal site.

OR

An existing building of approximately 700 square feet on a suitable site; parking and maneuvering area for approximately 8 vehicles; and a dock or other provision for truck loading and unloading. The building must meet Federal Handicapped Accessibility Standards at the time of occupancy or be capable of being modified to meet such. The building/site should be properly zoned or capable of being rezoned for use as a postal facility.
