


**Selectmen's Meeting

Administrative:

Selectmen reviewed and initialed and or signed the following:

- A/P & P/R Warrant # 13
- Selectmen's minutes for June 5, 2017
- Reconciliation of Town Clerk's Checking account
- General journals 21,22,23 and 24
- Responses to a complaint by John Lewis about speeding on West Road
- A copy of a letter to David Harris from Ryan Leighton, Codes officer regarding a business being operated at 2285 Augusta Rd
- Copy of a letter from MMA to Deputy Chief Brown denying a safety enhancement grant at this time due to overwhelming response
- A check from Grimmel Industries for \$1019.00 for receipts from cleanup day

Other Business:

- John and Denise Pride asked the Selectmen if they could move the current plow turnaround from their driveway nearer the end of the Town maintained end adjacent to their barn on Skelton Road. The Pride's said they will pay to upgrade that section of Skelton Road to the condition of the current road and build a new turn around. Skelton Road was discontinued in 1936 from the Northeast corner of the barn to the corner of the pasture. John Mann was representing the Pride's and brought in a copy of the discontinuance along with a plan for the change.
- After reviewing the documents Marc made a motion in favor of the change and Michelle seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Marc said they will discuss this change with Rodney Skelton, who is currently the contractor plowing that road
- Clyde asked if the Town could abate the taxes on Account 1698, a mobile home on a rented lot. This is in tax acquired and abandoned. The former owner's whereabouts is unknown. They unanimously agreed to abate the taxes and let the landowner know he can dispose of the property as he sees fit.
- Regarding Account # 586, also in tax acquired, George Bernier received a call from someone handling the estate telling him they will not pay the taxes and we are not to send them any more notices. The Selectmen said we should advertise this property for sale at some point in time.
- Marc told Carol to expect a couple bills from MMWAC for trash dumped at the West Bowdoin site after cleanup day. Marc took one pick-up truck load to MMWAC 6/10/17 and the remainder 6/17/17. There were also 4 televisions and an A/C unit Marc took to the recycling center 6/10/17.
