


**Selectmen's Meeting

- An invite for the Selectmen and the Historic Preservation Committee to a grant writing for non-profits workshop at Bowdoin College on Thurs. Jan 17th.

- The Selectmen looked at estimates from three contractors and chose Ryan Page to do the removal of the marked pine trees around the Town office.
- Carol reminded the Selectboard the auditors will be here Tuesday and Wednesday.
- Carol also said the Budget worksheet and financial reports will be ready before the next meeting.
