

**Other Business:**

- **John Pride** came in to talk about a plan for building a climate-controlled storage facility on Skelton Road. He wants to pave the road, which he would pay for, and is asking for a possible tax deferral over a period of years to cover the costs. He is looking to employ a couple more residents. He stated it would only be a positive cash flow for the Town. He estimated the cost for paving at about \$28,000 to \$30,000.
- He will be going to the Planning Board with this.
- The selectmen asked Clyde to call MMA to find out the process.
- All town offices and the recycling center will be closed on December 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, and December 31<sup>st</sup> and January 1<sup>st</sup> for the holidays.
