


Selectmen's Meeting

The Road Commissioner came and said he had received 2 complaints in regard to a foggy morning about 30 degrees out and no sand on the roads. Rodney and Gary came over to Salt Shed and there wasn't a Loader in the yard. He said there needs to be a Loader here at night so the crew if need be, be able to get sand and salt for roads.

The Town Clerk gave the Selectman a description of how the Election process went. She felt the process went very well, she told us there were about 1800 voters, about 20 workers and the longest it took anyone in the line was 27 minutes, which was very good. The only small problem they had was when the first person went to put his ballot through, the machine would not accept it. They tried several things nothing worked. The Town Clerk called Augusta for help, she did what they instructed her to do and it fixed the problem and it was fine the rest of the time.

Michelle, Selectman discussed the Library in Topsham and how we would proceed with people being able to get reduced Library passes. We decided that we would pay for half of the cost of a pass. We budgeted \$3,000. In the budget for these passes. It will be the responsibility of the Library to send a bill itemizing the expenditure for the \$3,000., and the names of the people that received the reduced fee.
